

Volunteer Position Description *Brand Ambassador*

DESCRIPTION

Reports to: Volunteer Coordinator

Commitment: 6 month (minimum) commitment. Must volunteer for one event every 2 months to remain active.

Work Location: Varies depending on event

PURPOSE

EBHS Brand Ambassadors are the face of our organization out in the community at adoption events, fundraisers and other gatherings EBHS is invited to attend. Brand Ambassadors most commonly bring adoptable (or soon to be adoptable) dogs to these events, but on rare occasions, may be asked to bring a cat or small animal.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Following safe animal handling skills and procedures at all times
- Picking up EBHS adoptable and supplies at the shelter prior to event
- Setting up and taking down EBHS booth
- Returning EBHS adoptable and supplies back to the shelter following event
- Accurately answering questions on behalf of EBHS

QUALIFICATIONS

- Ability to work without direct supervision
- Ability to bend, squat, twist and stand for moderate lengths of time
- Organized, detail oriented and timely
- Excellent oral, written, and organizational skills with attention to detail.
- Outgoing and professional in demeanor with excellent customer service skills
- Must have animal handling experience
- 18 years or older
- Must attend new volunteer orientation, shadow a minimum of 2 events and go through Brand Ambassador training
- Able to lift and carry animals, equipment, and supplies in excess of 50 pounds
- Valid Driver's License
- Passion for issues relating to animal welfare
- Work respectfully with and alongside staff and volunteers

WORK ENVIRONMENT

- Physical demands include:
 - Lifting and moving animals and other equipment.
 - Frequent movement, including but not limited to; standing, walking, stooping, carrying heavy loads, movement of kennels and operation of motor vehicles.
- Working conditions include:
 - Possible exposure to dangerous, diseased, frightened, and injured animals.
 - Possible exposure to zoonotic diseases.
